

FRIENDS OF LUCY'S MILL BRIDGE – LUCY'S LIFT FUN COMPETITION

RULES

- 1) This competition is open to young people aged 12 or under as of 1st January 2017
- 2) There is only one entry per young person
- 3) An entry can be up to three pictures/pages using the outline pictures provided on the Friends of Lucy's Mill web site or any other format, as long as each page/picture is in LANDSCAPE format. Portrait pictures cannot be accepted
- 4) Where a young person creates a physical model of the bridge (using any commercial modelling products or by making a model from cardboard etc) that entry cannot be physically sent to The Friends of Lucy's Mill Bridge. It should be photographed and pictures of the model sent to the entry addresses, Pictures should be of a file size of 1-2M to ensure that they can be printed to a high quality and on A4 paper.
A young person can send in up to three pictures of their model. If only one picture is sent, the young person should choose a view they feel best represents their work. If more than one picture is sent, the other pictures should show different views of the model, say from the side and from above. Judging for the prizes will be solely based on the images (pictures/pages) sent by ALL entrants. There is no separate category for models
- 5) The closing date for the competition is 5pm on Tuesday 5th September 2017

Where entries are posted, the name, age, address and a contact telephone number **MUST** be written on the back of each page of an entry

Where entries are sent by e-mail, the body of the e-mail **MUST** include the name of the entrant, their age, their address and a contact number

- 7) A full list of prizes and how they will be awarded (age groups etc) will be published by the closing date but no prize will be more than £10.00 in value
- 8) The judges for the competition will be the Friends of Lucy' Mill management committee + up to three invited guest judges. Judges' details will be published by Monday 11th September together with the date of the announcement of the winners (which will be no more than three weeks after 11th September). These dates cannot be fixed (announced as of the opening of this competition on 14/7/17) as The Friends are unable to confirm the date of their Autumn Exhibition at the moment.
- 9) This competition makes no offer that a winning entrant's work (any aspect of their design) will be used in any way in the renovation of Lucy's Mill Bridge or in any other additions to river crossings in Stratford. By entering this competition, the entrant's work will be in the public domain so negating protection of intellectual and copyright protection rights.
By entering this competition, the young person and their guardians give The Friends of Lucy's Mill Bridge the full rights to display their entry on the Friends of Lucy's Mill Bridge web site and social media accounts, for display purposes at any exhibition the Friends hold,

and for use in any presentation the Friends make to interested parties

10) When any picture is displayed, in any format, it will only be captioned with the Christian name of young person

11) If an entry is awarded a prize, it is solely the decision of the young person and their guardians if they wish to take part in any publicity about/of their success, and how the promotion is then distributed through The Friends owned media and the generic media of the locality and beyond

12) No entries can be returned. If a young person and their family want to have a record of what they have done, they should take all the pictures (of the entry) they require before submitting that entry.

If an entry is a physical model, images of it should be submitted as per No 4) but the Friends MAY ask if the complete model could be available for an exhibition. If the model is from young people's construction materials which are then used for other play etc or cannot be kept intact, this will not affect any prize decisions. Entrants and their families should not keep a model presuming that it will then be displayed
