BYELAWS

RECREATION GROUND AND BOROUGH SPORTS FIELD STRATFORD-UPON-AVON

Made under Sections 12 and 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 by the Stratford-on-Avon District Council with regard to the Pleasure Grounds known as the Recreation Ground and Borough Sports Field.

1. In this Byelaw the expression "the Council" means the Stratford-on-Avon District Council and the expression "the pleasure ground" means each of the pleasure grounds known as the Recreation Ground and Borough Sports Field in Stratford-upon-Avon.
2. An act necessary to the proper execution of his duty in the pleasure ground by an officer of the Council or by any person or servant of any person employed by the Council, shall not be deemed an offence against this Byelaw.
3. No person shall in the pleasure ground chip pitch or drive a solid golf ball:

Provided that this prohibition shall not apply to any space in the pleasure ground set apart by the Council for use as a Putting Green and described as such in a notice board affixed to such space.

4. Any person offending against this Byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.
5. Any person offending against this Byelaw may be removed from the pleasure ground by any officer of the Council, or by any constable in any one of the several cases hereinafter specified, that is to say:-

- (i) where the infraction of this byelaw is committed within the view of such officer or constable, and the name and residence of the person infringing the byelaw are unknown to and cannot be readily ascertained by such officer or constable.

- (ii) where the infraction of this byelaw is committed within the view of such officer or constable, and, from the nature of such infraction, or from any other fact of which such officer or constable may have knowledge, or of which he may be credibly informed, there may be reasonable ground for belief that the continuance in the pleasure ground of the person infringing this byelaw may result in another infraction of the byelaw, or that the removal of such person from the pleasure ground is otherwise necessary as a security for the proper use and regulation thereof.
